EXPLORING AVONDALE'S NATURAL SIDE

If the idea of hiking, birdwatching, or simply sitting near a pond watching the clouds roll by makes your heart beat a little slower (in the best way), you're in the right place.

Avondale might surprise you with just how green, wild, and alive it feels once you step outside and into the sun-dappled calm of the great outdoors.

From mountain trails to wetlands filled with life, this desert city knows how to serve up fresh air with a side of "whoa, is that a bald eagle?"



Estrella Mountain Regional Park

Desert Adventure with Room to Breathe

Let's start big. Estrella Mountain Regional Park is basically Avondale's backyard wilderness with nearly 20,000 acres of rolling desert hills, winding trails, and views that'll make you forget all about your inbox. Whether you're looking for a hike, a horseback ride, or a lazy picnic under a mesquite tree, this park delivers. The trail options range from "I just want a peaceful walk and to eat snacks at the halfway point" to "Let's see if my quads survive this."

But before you leave Estrella Mountain Regional Park, don't miss the chance to hike up to Monument Hill. It's a little-known spot with a surprisingly big story. Nestled just east of Phoenix Raceway, this humble-looking rise is home to Arizona's "Initial Point," a historic survey marker that literally set the starting point for all land surveying in the state. Yep, everything - maps, boundaries, property lines - starts right here. It's a short, steep climb, but the view from the top makes it so worth it. It's one of those hidden gems you can casually name-drop later and say, "Oh, you haven't been to the beginning of all of Arizona? Wild." The very first marker was placed here in 1851, back when the Gila River, which is visible from the summit, marked the original boundary between the United States and Mexico. Today, it's a must-visit for history buffs, geo-nerds, and anyone who loves a good Instagram-worthy scenic shot.

White Tank Mountains

Where the Cactus Blooms and the Views Stretch for Miles

Technically a little north of Avondale, but well worth the short drive, the White Tanks' 29,000+ acres offer the kind of hike that turns casual walkers into accidental nature lovers. Trails snake through saguaros and boulders, with plenty of spots to pause, catch your breath, and say, "Arizona is something else." The waterfall trail (yep, a waterfall in the desert) is a favorite, especially in spring after a good rain. And if you're a sunrise hiker? This is your spot.



Crystal Gardens Wetlands

The Best-Kept Secret for Lazy Day Exploring

Don't let the word "wetlands" fool you. This is Avondale, not the Everglades. Crystal Gardens is a water reclamation project with a series of lakes and walking paths that attract ducks, egrets, turtles, and a surprising number of joggers who actually look like they enjoy it. It's peaceful, family-friendly, and ridiculously photogenic during golden hour. Bring a thermos of ice water and a friend you don't mind walking in silence with. Bonus points if you pack trail mix that doesn't include raisins. No one likes those.



Tres Rios

The Birdwatcher's Playground

Now let's get nerdy (in the most terrific way). Tres Rios is where the Salt, Gila, and Agua Fria Rivers meet. It's a haven for nature lovers, especially the ones who get a little

giddy spotting herons or hawks. This place is teeming with wildlife. And we stand behind that promise. You've got river otters frolicking about, turtles sunbathing like they've got nowhere to be, and birds. So many birds. More than 200 birds and wildlife species call this place home, and honestly? Most of them are 100% fabulous. It's the spot where you'll start out saying, "I'm just here to stretch my legs," and end up whisper-yelling an hour later, "Did you see that egret?!"

Ditch the Phone (Except for Pics) and Go Outside



Avondale's natural side doesn't need neon signs or rollercoasters to get your attention. It's soft desert wind, birdsong, the crunch of trail underfoot, and that moment where everything gets quiet and you suddenly feel...ahhhh...better. So go ahead and lace up your sneakers, fill your water bottle, and let nature work its magic. The emails can wait.


The only North American owl that nests underground.

Just east of Avondale, you'll find the Nina Mason Pulliam Rio Salado Audubon Center (aka birdwatching heaven, but with air conditioning). This place is a full-on nature escape in the middle of the city, where you can stroll shady trails, spot over 200 species of birds, and check out free exhibits that make science feel less like homework and more like a "did you see that?!" moment. Admission is free!

Avondale is a dream destination for dessert lovers, thanks to a lineup of locally-owned spots crafting everything from French pastries to frozen creations. Here are a few can't-miss stops to satisfy your sweet tooth while you're in town.

1. Crepella Crepes Café

1461 N. Dysart Rd., Avondale, AZ 85323

Our first stop is bringing a taste of France to Avondale. Crepella Crepes Café takes the classic French crepe to the next level, balancing decadence with delicacy. Each bon bon is a miniature work of art—expertly molded, vibrantly colored, and filled with rich, chocolate flavors like coffee lovers, passionfruit mango, or suspended vanilla caramel. Not to be outdone, the French macarons come in classic flavors like pistachio and sea salt caramel, or you can venture into the more tropical with pina colada and mango chile. Whether you're picking up a gift box or treating yourself to a post-dinner indulgence, MAE's bon bons and macarons deliver a melt-in-your-mouth experience that's as beautiful as it is delicious.

3. Nautical Bowls

Their smoothies and bowls are not only refreshing and energizing, but they also feel like dessert without the guilt. Whether you're fueling up post-workout or cooling off on a hot day, Nautical Bowls is a go-to spot for a feel-good treat that tastes as amazing as it looks.

4. Robeks Fresh Juices & Smoothies

6. TJ's Homestyle Restaurant

This last one feels just like home. If your idea of the perfect dessert leans warm, nostalgic, and made from scratch, TJ's Homestyle Restaurant is a must-visit in Avondale. Located in the heart of Old Town, this longtime local favorite delivers all the cozy, down-home charm you'd expect—with a dessert menu that's pure comfort on a plate. Their house-made pies are the star of the show, each slice served with a generous dollop of whipped cream or a scoop of vanilla ice cream for the full diner experience. But the real showstopper? The cinnamon roll—a warm, gooey spiral of cinnamon-sugar goodness, glazed with just the right amount of icing that melts into every soft bite. It's the kind of treat you'll want to split, but probably won't.

From nostalgic comfort bakes to refreshing superfood bowls and creative drink concoctions, Avondale's dessert scene proves that sweet moments can be found in every corner of the city. Whether you're a visitor looking to explore local flavors or a longtime resident with a serious sweet tooth, these spots offer more than just sugar—they serve up community, creativity, and a whole lot of joy.




Competition Meets Community



BILLY MOORE DAYS

Celebrating Avondale's Heritage

When: October 22 – 25, 2026

Where: Festival Fields Park, 101 E. Lower Buckeye Rd., Avondale, AZ 85323

Billy Moore was the original settler of this area back in the 1800s, long before Avondale had stoplights, schools, or the food truck scene it has today. He set up a stagecoach stop near the Agua Fria River and called the place Coldwater. Eventually, the town changed its name to Avondale. However, Billy's legacy still rides high in the saddle, especially come October, when the city celebrates him with a weekend full of hometown pride.

Billy Moore Days is a multi-day affair with a full schedule of festivities including a parade, carnival rides, games, a beer garden, and live family-friendly entertainment.



AVONDALE FIESTA

Cinco de Mayo Celebration

When: May 2, 2026

Where: Old Town Avondale on Historic Western Avenue

Every May, as the desert heat starts to rise, Avondale turns up the cultural temperature with its Avondale Fiesta. This free, family-friendly event is a heartfelt nod to the city's Mexican heritage, bringing the community together in a lively nighttime festival.

Stroll down Western Avenue and the smell of mouth-watering authentic Mexican cuisine will grab you (who can resist?!). It's not just about the food (but it's worth noting that there is a bona fide salsa showdown). It's Latinx culture in full color, food vendors slinging everything from tacos to tamales, artisan crafts, and a vibe that says, "you're not going home early tonight." This festival offers a glimpse into the artistic traditions passed down through generations.

For the young, the Kermés en la Biblioteca at Sam Garcia Library offers carnival games and lotería, a traditional Mexican board game, ensuring smiles all around. It's more than just a festival; it's a celebration of community, culture, and the ties that bind us all.

Avondale Through the Decades

BEFORE WE WERE AVONDALE



Avondale's founding father, William "Billy" G. Moore, arrived in Arizona in the late 1860s, settling near the Agua Fria River in 1880. He called the area "Coldwater, Arizona," after the river. Back then, Coldwater was just a general store and stage stop near the Agua Fria river crossing. The City took its name from "Avondale Ranch," where the post office was established in 1896.



1940s

Agua Fria High School opened (1956), and Billy Moore Days was started by the Chamber of Commerce (1954).



1940s

This decade established Avondale as a City, with its incorporation in 1946. The first official census determined the population to be 2,232 residents. This post-WW2 era gave many in the community the opportunity to start a family or begin a business in downtown Avondale. The outlying area was mainly farm fields and was sparsely populated.



1960s

Phoenix Raceway was established (1964). The original owner built the track with dreams that it would be someday known as the "Indianapolis of the West."

1970s

The city was still relatively small, at only 3.5 miles in size, and a population of 7,000. All residents lived west of the Agua Fria River. Mountain View Park was the first official park in the city. Avondale's first public library broke ground in 1973.



1980s

The population started to boom in this decade, nearly doubling every census until the early 2000s. The city provided important services and more infrastructure to keep up with the growth. Garden Lakes was the first master planned housing development in Avondale. The Cashion community was annexed (1987).



1990s

Higher education opportunities arrived in Avondale when Estrella Mountain Community College was built (1992). The city now had two high schools, with Westview HS serving residents north of the Agua Fria River. Farmland was still a prevalent part of the landscape during this decade.




2000s

This decade marked a period of significant changes. The Civic Center Campus was developed (2003). The Randall McDaniel Sports Complex was built (2009), and 115th Avenue was renamed Avondale Blvd (2003). The city's retail base grew with the arrival of large retail hubs such as Gateway Pavilions, Gateway Crossing, and the Avondale Automall.



2010s

Quality of life opportunities continued to grow. Avondale was named an All-America City (2014). The Tres Rios area in Avondale was designated as a significant birding corridor by the National Audubon Society. The ZOOM Bus circulator service began (2010), and Festival Fields Park opened (2019).

2020s


Avondale's population at the start of this decade is 93,000 and growing! As the City continues to expand with new housing, businesses, and jobs, it's also investing in modern amenities such as the Mayor Marie Lopez Rogers Complex and expanding Festival Fields (2020); Fairway Drive Interchange off Interstate 10, and The BLVD development (2021); the Avondale Visitor and Conference Center, Alamar Park, and its 5th Fire Station (2022); and the Avondale Aquatic Center and Mountain View Park improvements (2024). Avondale's WeRide micro-transit program launches in 2022, an immediate success. Avondale's West Valley Health Quarter expands during this decade, along with significant data center investment. From 2020 – 2025, Avondale was the host city for the NASCAR Championship Weekend.

Not Just a Pit Stop


